Fort Collins, CO – Odell Brewing has partnered with Johnson Brothers to bring the Colorado-based brewery's beers to Iowa. Distribution will include both draft and package available throughout the entire state starting in April.

The brewery's launch in Iowa will mark the 12th state within its distribution footprint and the first in two years.
