- Assisting in process automation and PLC (Programmable Logic Controller) design/build
- Assisting in process improvement of packaging, brewing, and facility processes
- Assisting in developing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) and future maintenance programs
- Daily cleaning and organizing of maintenance area
- Working in a 24-hour shift rotation that involves late nights, weekends, and holidays
